Leaving Queenscliff twice daily during the warmer months, conducts tours within the southern reaches of Port Phillip Bay. Swimming with dolphins is controlled by strict legislation (deservedly so!) and our patient instructors will ensure that both snorkellers and dolphins benefit from the experience.
